
DISASSEMBLY

- 1. Remove end plug (1) from housing (10).
- 2. Remove o-ring (2) from end plug (1).
- 3. Remove spring (3) and poppet (4) from housing (10).
- 4. Using a brass hooked tool, carefully remove sleeve (6). NOTE: Be careful not to scratch or mar sleeve (6) or housing (10) bore.
- 5. Remove o-rings (5 & 7) from sleeve (6).
- 6. Remove poppet (8) and spring (9) from housing (10).

ASSEMBLY

LUBRICATE ALL RUBBER COMPONENTS FROM REPAIR KIT WITH CLEAN TYPE FLUID USED IN THE SYSTEM.

- 1. Clean all parts thoroughly before assembling.
- 2. Insert spring (9) into bottom of housing (10) bore. Center new poppet (8) in spring (9). Note direction of poppet (8).
- 3. Install new o-rings (5 & 7) on sleeve (6). Carefully insert sleeve (6) into housing (10) bore until it bottoms out.
- 4. Insert new poppet (4) into sleeve (6). Note direction of poppet (4).
- 5. Place spring (3) on end of poppet (4).
- 6. Install new o-ring (2) on end plug (1). Install end plug (1) in housing (10) and torque 40.7-67.8 N·m (30-50 lb·ft).
